 - Fr. Willie was in touch with Lisa Wright from archdiocese about the Lenten appeal. Pastoral council members will cover commitment weekend. Terry 5pm Mass, Bob 8:30 Mass and Ed at 11:15 Mass and Fr. Willie will cover announcement weekend
 - The council all agreed that our rebate from Lenten Appeal could be used to assist Annunciation parish in Rosedale.

- Dick Berndt mentioned that 11:15 Mass seems to be a fertile ground to reaching out to new folks. Pastoral council encouraged to try to attend 11:15 once a month to help shake hands & introduce themselves & greet (donut Sunday- first Sunday of the month.
